1	1	Abrams Creek flows over a beaver ( <i>Castor canadensis</i> ) dam
1	2	A single red wolf ( <i>Canis rufus</i> ) howls
1	3	A howling wolf makes a chainsaw-like sound and a new group joins the chorus
1	4	As two wolf groups interact, barking commences
1	5	Snow falls, followed by a branch snap
1	6	A three-part branch crack-snap
1	7	A clod of snow falls
1	8	Small branch cracks but stays attached to the tree
1	9	A large branch breaks, scattering snow
1	10	A tree falls under the weight of 18 inches of snow
1	11	A branch dumps its load of snow, which tumbles across the ground
1	12	A quarter-sized fountain bubbles forth cool water and Spring Peepers ( <i>Hyla crucifer</i> ) call in the background
1	13	The sound of a swirling creek swollen with snow with Spring Peepers ( <i>Hyla crucifer</i> ) calling in the distance
1	14	The sound of an eddy in the creek
1	15	The sound of the creek and the start of a gentle rain
1	16	Rain sweeping across the surface of the creek
1	17	An Eastern Phoebe ( <i>Sayornis phoebe</i> ) sings from a sycamore along a creek

1	19	An Eastern Phoebe ( <i>Sayornis phoebe</i> ) sings from a sycamore along a creek
1	20	An American Crow ( <i>Corvus brachyrhynchos</i> ) calls

1	22	A raccoon ( <i>Procyon lotor</i> ) walks by as Spring Peepers ( <i>Hyla crucifer</i> ) increase their calling
1	23	A Barred Owl ( <i>Strix varia</i> ) calls in dense woods
1	24	A Barred Owl ( <i>Strix varia</i> ) hoots and the raccoon ( <i>Procyon lotor</i> ) makes churring noises
1	25	The raccoon ( <i>Procyon lotor</i> ) continues his dinner patrol
1	26	Peepers call and Wood Frogs ( <i>Rana sylvatica</i> ) begin their quacking calls
1	27	Upland Chorus Frogs ( <i>Pseudacris triseriata feriarum</i> ) give their sharp, ratchety calls along with a chorus of Spring Peepers ( <i>Hyla crucifer</i> )
1	28	A gentle rain starts to fall
1	29	An American Toad ( <i>Bufo americanus</i> ) joins the chorus
1	30	Another call from the American Toad ( <i>Bufo americanus</i> )
1	31	Upland Chorus Frogs ( <i>Pseudacris triseriata feriarum</i> ) call from a meadow
1	32	Wolves calling in the distance
1	33	Wolves barking and yapping
1	34	The drumming of a Pileated Woodpecker ( <i>Dryocopus pileatus</i> ) is heard from a treetop You also hear the Solitary Vireo ( <i>Vireo solitarius</i> ), Carolina Wren ( <i>Thryothorus ludovicianus</i> ), and Northern Cardinal ( <i>Cardinalis cardinalis</i> ) in the background
1	35	A second Pileated Woodpecker ( <i>Dryocopus pileatus</i> ) joins the drumming of the first
1	36	Drumming of two Pileated Woodpeckers ( <i>Dryocopus pileatus</i> )
1	37	A Hairy Woodpecker ( <i>Picoides villosus</i> ) flies away
1	38	The rattle call of the Hairy Woodpecker ( <i>Picoides villosus</i> )
1	39	The singing of a Carolina Wren ( <i>Thryothorus ludovicianus</i> )

1	51	A Wood Thrush ( <i>Hylocichla mustelina</i> ) joins the dawn chorus

1	58	Quiet bellow of a cow, bubbling creek, and Green Frog ( <i>Rana clamitans</i> ) call

1	60	Green Frog ( <i>Rana clamitans</i> ) call followed by crunching sound
1	61	Dawn chorus and sound of Canada Geese ( <i>Branta canadensis</i> ) overhead
